### REPORTING PRACTICE SUMMARY - 2022

Burkina Faso's reporting changed slightly in its 2022 annual report.

Burkina Faso continued to submit a 'nil' report for exports.

Burkina Faso reported **Actual Numbers** of SALW, whereas in 2021 it reported both authorized and actual numbers. In 2022, it did not report any major conventional weapons imports.



### GOOD PRACTICES

Burkina Faso submitted a 'nil' report for exports, indicating clearly it had no exports to report in 2022.

Burkina Faso provided disaggregated numbers for its SALW and major conventional weapons imports by weapon type.



### ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT

Burkina Faso excluded some data for 'commercial sensitivity/national security-related' reasons but did not specify where or how much information was withheld.

Burkina Faso aggregated some countries supplying its major conventional and SALW imports, making it impossible in some cases to determine from where small arms items were exported.

Burkina Faso could provide more descriptions and comments describing the nature of more of its reported exports.

Burkina Faso could indicate clearly that there were no reported exports or imports in specific weapons categories and sub-categories rather than leaving relevant sections of the reporting template blank.



### TRANSFER SUMMARY - 2022: EXPORT DATA

- Burkina Faso submitted a 'nil' report for exports.



### TRANSFER SUMMARY - 2022: IMPORT DATA

- Burkina Faso reported imports from nine countries in 2022. Of these, seven were ATT States Parties and two were Signatories.
- Burkina Faso reported the imports of six major conventional weapons, all of which were combat transport vehicles reported under the category 'other' from the United Arab Emirates.
- Burkina Faso reported the import of 30,284 SALW items. Of these, the majority were assault rifles (89.4 per cent), revolvers and self-loading pistols (7.2 per cent) and light machine guns (1.4 per cent).
