REPORTING PRACTICE SUMMARY - 2022

This was Cyprus' first public report.

Cyprus reported **Authorized Numbers** and **Values** of small arms exports. Cyprus reported **Actual Numbers** and **Values** of small arms imports. It did not report major conventional weapons exports or imports.



GOOD PRACTICES

Cyprus provided descriptions and comments for the majority of its imports.



ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT

Cyprus aggregated final importing/exporting countries making it impossible in some cases to determine from where small arms were imported/exported.

Cyprus could indicate clearly that there were no reported exports or imports in specific weapons categories and sub-categories rather than leaving relevant sections of the reporting template blank.



TRANSFER SUMMARY - 2022: EXPORT DATA

- Cyprus reported exports to 16 countries in 2022. Of these, four were ATT States Parties, three were Signatories and nine were non-members (Azerbaijan, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Jordan, Kyrgyzstan, Pakistan and Saudi Arabia).
- Cyprus did not report exports of major conventional weapons in its 2022 annual report.
- Cyprus reported the export of 770 SALW with a total value of €1.2m (US\$1.4m).¹



TRANSFER SUMMARY - 2022: IMPORT DATA

- Cyprus reported imports from three countries in 2022. Of these, two were ATT States Parties and one was a Signatory.
- Cyprus did not report imports of major conventional weapons in its 2022 annual report.
- Cyprus reported the import of 411 revolvers and self-loading pistols, with a total value of €151,367 (US\$159,333).²
- In terms of numbers, the exporters were Germany (87.1 per cent), Austria (11.7 per cent) and Israel (1.2 per cent).
