REPORTING PRACTICE SUMMARY - 2022

United Kingdom's reporting changed in 2022.

United Kingdom reported **Numbers** of exports of major conventional weapons and SALW, whereas in 2021 it reported **Authorized Numbers**.

It reported **Numbers** of major conventional weapons imports for the first time.

**GOOD PRACTICES**

United Kingdom provided clear, disaggregated data for major conventional weapons imports and exports and SALW exports.

United Kingdom provided descriptions and comments on the nature of all its major conventional weapons exports and imports and some SALW exports.

**ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT**

United Kingdom did not indicate whether its exports and imports were authorized or actual.

United Kingdom could provide comments describing the nature of more of its reported imports and exports.

**TRANSFER SUMMARY - 2022: EXPORT DATA**

- United Kingdom reported exports to 70 countries in 2022. Of these, 45 were ATT States Parties, 14 were Signatories and 11 were non-members (Brunei Darussalam, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Jordan, Kenya, Kuwait, Oman, Pakistan, Qatar and Saudi Arabia).
- United Kingdom reported the export of 1,027 major conventional weapons, covering six categories. The majority of these were armoured combat vehicles (89.7 per cent), missiles and missile launchers (MANPADS) (5 per cent) and manned combat aircraft (2.4 per cent).
- The main importers of major conventional weapons from the United Kingdom were Sweden (56 per cent), Ukraine (32.4 per cent) and Indonesia (3.3 per cent).
- United Kingdom reported the export of 68,585 SALW items, covering seven sub-categories. Of these, the majority were rifles and carbines (96.7 per cent), assault rifles (2.1 per cent) and heavy machine guns (0.5 per cent).
- The main importers of SALW from the United Kingdom were the United States (75.4 per cent), Australia (4.5 per cent) and South Africa (4 per cent).

**TRANSFER SUMMARY - 2022: IMPORT DATA**

- United Kingdom reported the import of 18 major conventional weapons from one Signatory (United States). These were manned attack helicopters (77.8 per cent) and manned combat aircraft (22.2 per cent).
